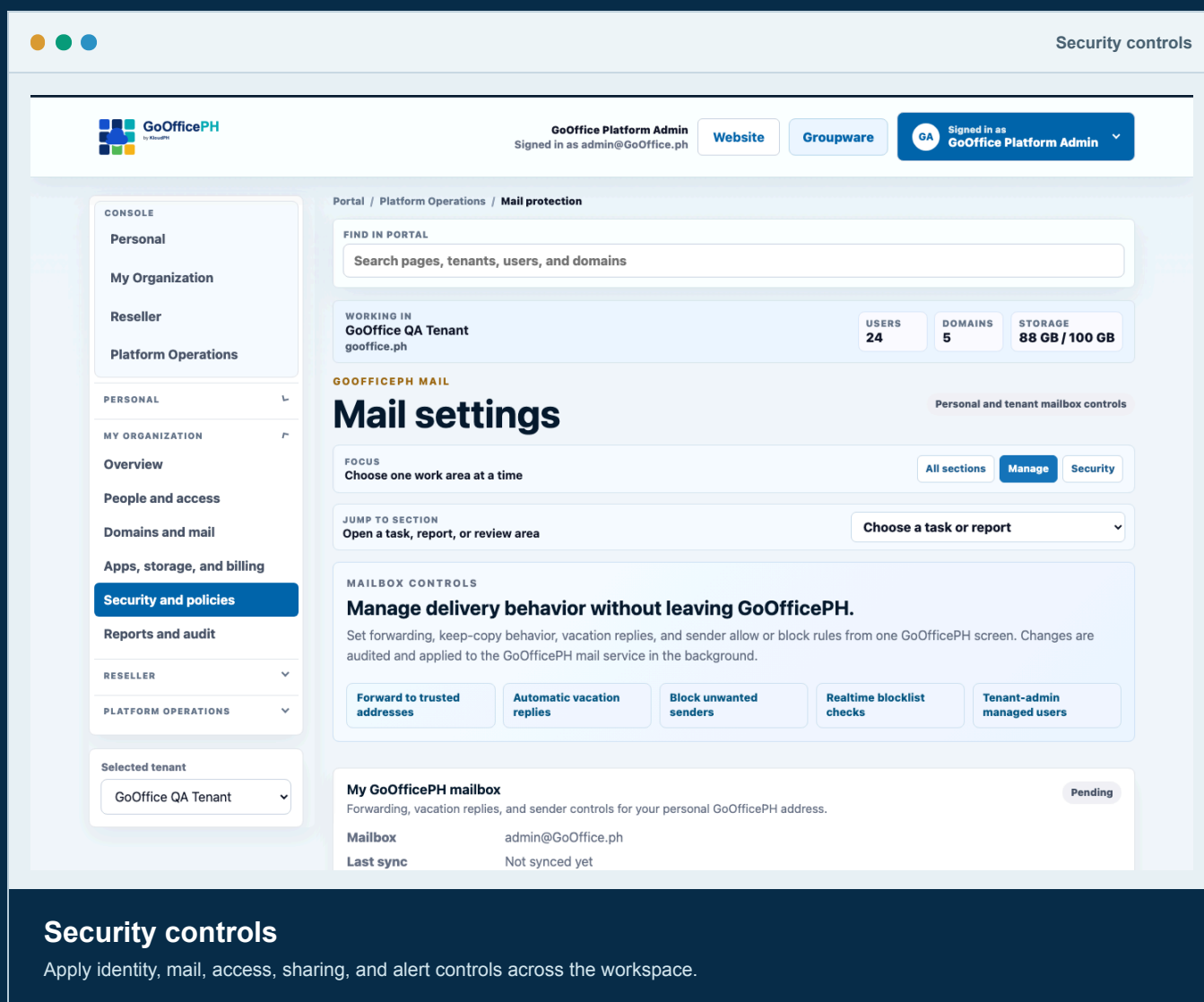

Security controls

Apply identity, mail, access, sharing, and alert controls across the workspace.

We combine organization policy with user-facing signals so security decisions remain understandable from sign-in through mail delivery, file sharing, meetings, and platform operations.

Protect identity

Apply strong passwords, recovery, re-authentication, role boundaries, and multifactor controls.

Protect communication

Use platform, tenant, and user mail policies with outbound limits, scanning, alerts, and emergency controls.

Protect shared work

Keep file, room, whiteboard, and app permissions tied to accountable people and organizations.

The application experience and the controls around it operate as one GoOfficePH service.



Follow the task from entry to outcome.

Make the experience simple without hiding operational depth.

OPERATING AREAS

Identity and privileged access

Account recovery, MFA, role assignment, re-authentication, session handling, and staff permission review.

OPERATING AREAS

Mail protection

Inbound and outbound policy layers, sender reputation, recipient limits, anomaly detection, quarantine, and alert routing.

OPERATING AREAS

Sharing and collaboration

Tenant and domain membership, guest access, file permissions, room policy, host controls, and revocation.

OPERATING AREAS

Operational response

Alerts, reports, audit trails, mailbox or tenant sending restrictions, and permission-gated kill switches.

Security controls features - 1 of 2

Technical readers can scan the implemented capability. Everyone else can read what that capability changes in everyday work.

TECHNICAL CAPABILITY	WHAT IT MEANS FOR YOU
IDENTITY	
Minimum password policy and clear validation	Tell users exactly what a valid password requires.
Alternate contact recovery	Deliver recovery instructions to a reachable address when the GoOfficePH mailbox is inaccessible.
Multifactor authentication policy	Add another proof of identity for administrators and protected accounts.
Recent re-authentication	Require a fresh sign-in before consequential actions.
Session and role boundaries	Prevent one account scope from silently inheriting another scope's authority.
MAIL	
Authenticated outbound submission	Prevent anonymous use of GoOfficePH as an open mail relay.
Platform, tenant, and user policy layers	Keep minimum protection active even when lower-level settings are permissive.
New-account reputation tiers	Start new senders with measured limits that grow with clean history.
Per-user and per-domain recipient limits	Contain a compromised account or tenant without stopping everyone else.
Outbound queue quotas	Prevent one sender from filling the delivery queue.
Outbound spam, phishing, URL, malware, and attachment scanning	Stop harmful messages before they leave the platform.
Bounce and complaint thresholds	Restrict sending when recipient feedback signals abuse or poor list quality.
Behavioral anomaly detection	Flag sudden volume, destination, login, forwarding, or app-password changes.
Sender, mailbox, tenant, and external-send kill switches	Contain an incident without unnecessarily disabling incoming mail.
SPF, DKIM, DMARC, and ARC support	Protect domain identity and improve receiving-system trust.

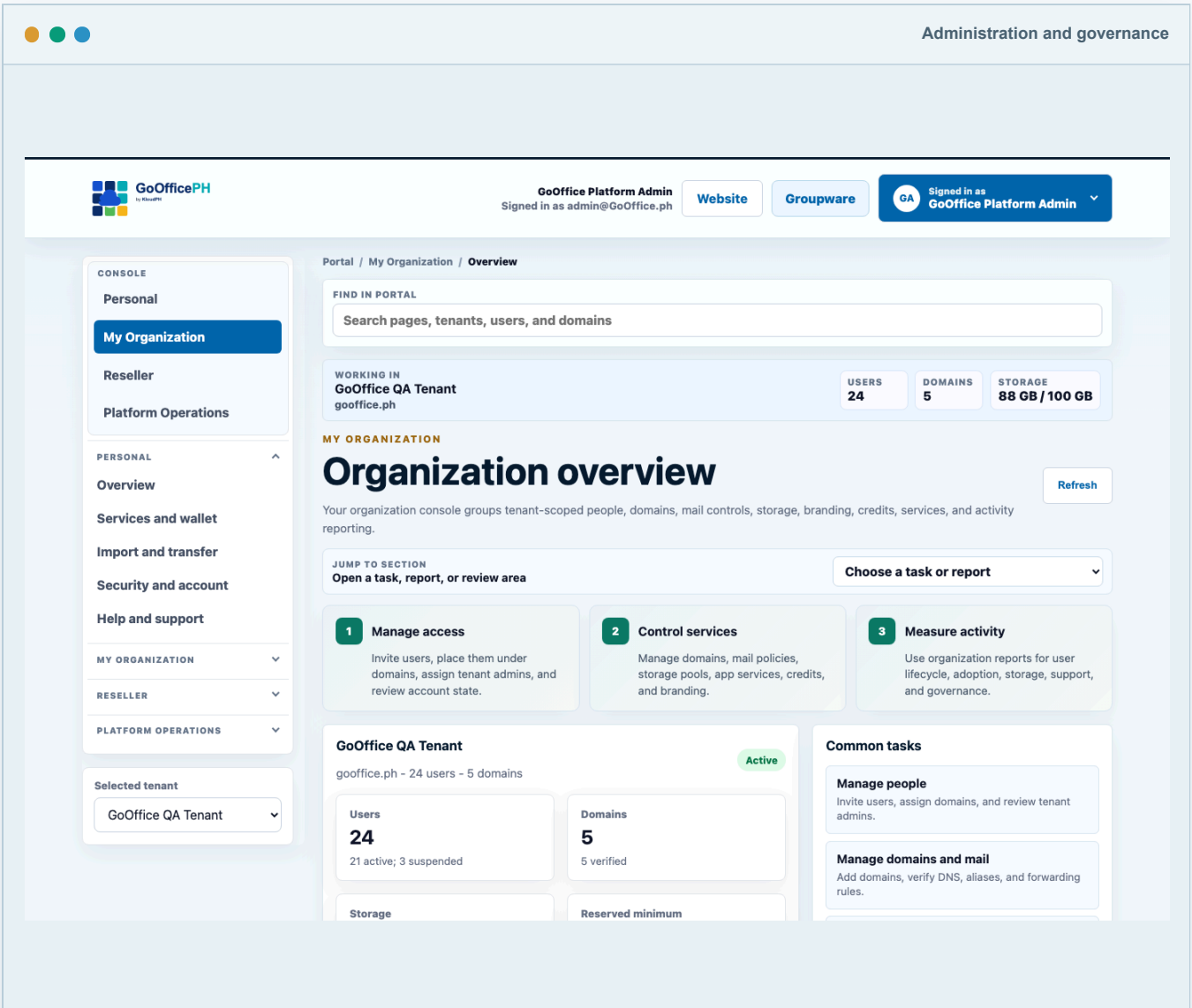
Security controls features - 2 of 2

Technical readers can scan the implemented capability. Everyone else can read what that capability changes in everyday work.

TECHNICAL CAPABILITY	WHAT IT MEANS FOR YOU
SHARING	
File and folder permissions	Keep managed content limited to intended viewers and editors.
Guest and link controls	Collaborate externally without opening the wider organization.
MEETINGS	
Room, waiting-room, media, recording, and transcription policy	Let hosts and administrators control how meetings operate.
WHITEBOARD	
Host enablement and attributed annotation	Keep visual collaboration accountable to the room.
ALERTS	
Role-based security alert routing	Send a finding to the person who can act on it.
RESPONSE	
Quarantine, restriction, and review workflows	Pause risky activity while preserving evidence for a decision.
EVIDENCE	
Security events and policy-change audit	Review what happened and which control changed.
REPORTS	
Personal, organization, and platform security reports	Give users, tenant administrators, and staff an appropriate view of risk.

Role-aware administration

People, services, policy, and evidence remain connected to the application.

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Introduce the capability around a real outcome.

Confirm the audience

Identify the users, tenant, domains, roles, and external participants involved.

Set policy and access

Apply the organization's service, security, sharing, storage, and retention requirements.

Move a real workflow

Use representative content and measure whether the new path improves clarity and follow-through.

Review and expand

Use activity, support, audit, and report data before increasing the rollout.

Platform capability available to the roles and plans authorized for its scope.

Open the current product page, production catalog, and release history.
